CO-OP HOSTS LEGISLATIVE EVENT

More than 110 Firelands Electric members, employees, and trustees gathered on Sept. 12 for the cooperative's 2022 ACRE Co-op Owners for Political Action breakfast and legislative event.

Several local and state government officials representing portions of Firelands Electric's four-county service territory participated in the event, which was held at the cooperative's facility in New London. Attendees were provided updates on legislative issues currently affecting electric cooperatives and their local communities. Topics included supply chain delays, increasing material costs, reliability of the electric grid, and workforce challenges. Co-op members were also encouraged to participate in a Q&A segment.

Ohio Representative Marilyn John opened the presentations with a discussion on Ohio's current workforce, including staffing shortages, development, and education. Ohio Representative Darrell Kick spoke on the recent redistricting of the state's house districts. He also reviewed the newly passed House Bill 30, which requires Amish buggies and other animal-drawn vehicles to install yellow flashing lights to improve safety.

Ohio Representative Dick Stein addressed the crowd regarding baseline power generation and the effect of electric vehicles on the grid, and Ohio Representative D.J. Swearingen, who will be serving portions of Huron County starting in 2023, spoke on the agricultural industry and school funding. Kyle Brooks, field representative to Ohio Congressman Bob Gibbs, reviewed college loan forgiveness, energy independence, and inflation.

Firelands Electric hosted the ACRE Co-op Owners breakfast to develop and foster relationships with legislators, while also providing a face-to-face forum for co-op members to meet and communicate with their elected officials. This exclusive event also recognized and thanked Firelands members who invest in ACRE

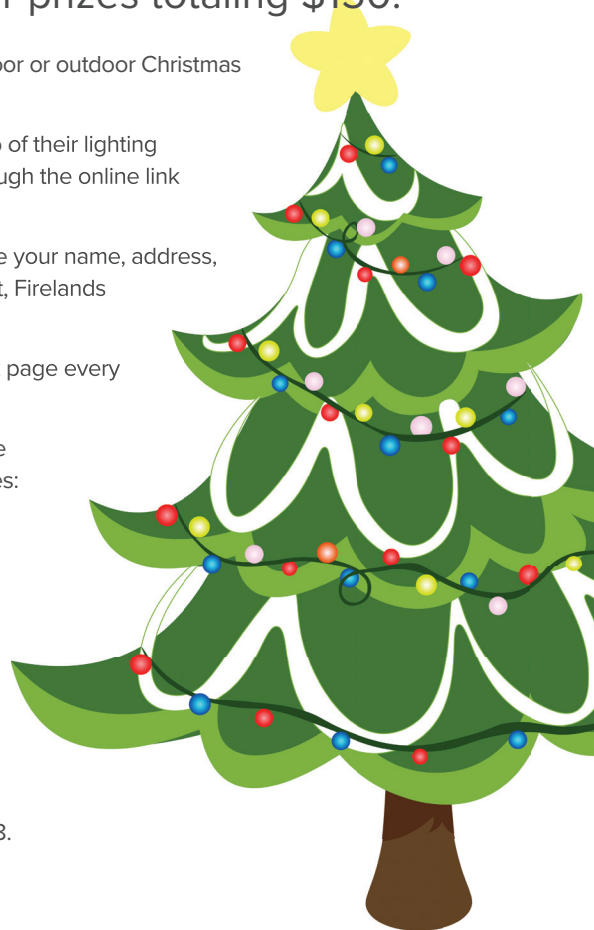
