Celebrating National Co-op Month

In 1936, a group of neighbors teamed up to find a way to bring electricity to parts of southern Huron County. At the time, many areas of rural America were extremely underserved by investor-owned utilities, with only about 10% having access to electric power.

After extensive research, Firelands' founders enlisted the help of the recently created Rural Electrification Administration (REA). By the summer of 1938, 100 miles of power lines were energized. Eighty-five years later, this number has grown to nearly 1,000 miles of line serving 9,200 homes, farms, and businesses in four counties. With the dedication and teamwork of the cooperative's first members, what had started out as the dream of a few became a reality for entire communities.

Established by, and for, the very people we serve, Firelands Electric maintains this distinctive business model to this day. As a result, there is a remarkably unique relationship between the cooperative's members, employees, and trustees. For starters, they share a community. Their children are on the same sports teams, they shop at the same stores, and they attend the same churches. Firelands Electric's members are our neighbors and our friends.

This close connection also drives Firelands' strong commitment to community. The co-op exists for our members, so our priority is to help the communities in which our members live and work so that they may grow and thrive. We do so not only by providing affordable, reliable power, but also by being in tune with the specific needs of our membership. 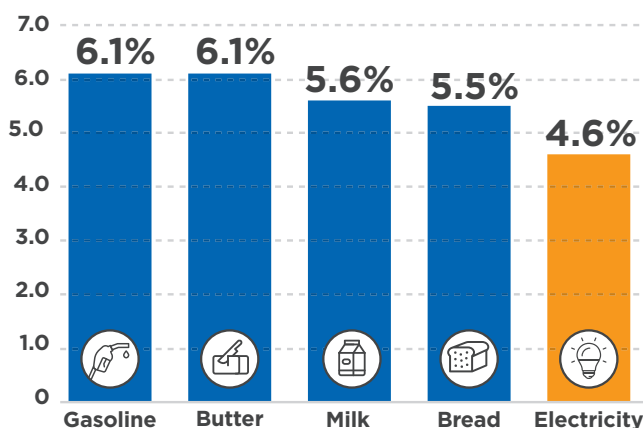

Stay informed by signing up to receive text notifications regarding power outages in your area. Follow these six simple steps to enroll. For more detailed instructions (with images) visit www.firelandsec.com/smarthub-101 and click on the link titled SmartHub Outage Alerts Setup Instructions.

1. Log in to your SmartHub account through the mobile app.
2. Open the Settings screen under the main menu.
3. Select Contact Methods.
4. Add your cellphone number. (If you receive a text message to verify this number, just follow the prompts.)
5. Navigate back to the Settings screen and select Manage Notifications.
6. Tap on Service and select Manage Contacts under the Power Outage tab. Move the slider next to the phone number to the right and tap Save.

CRACKING THE CODE ON GENERATOR OPTIONS



Generators can provide reliable backup power in the event of an outage. When choosing a generator, it's important to select the right type and size to fit your particular needs. Think about what you want your generator to power. Do you just want to keep your phone charged and your refrigerator cold? Do you want to make sure you have heat and air conditioning through an extended outage? Does someone in your household depend on medical equipment that is powered by electricity?

The answers to these and similar questions will help determine what type of generator you should purchase. For powering some lights, a phone charger, and a few appliances, a small portable unit would work. For long-term protection, including powering a heating or cooling system, a standby generator would be the better choice.

Let's take a brief look at the four main types of generators and what they can power:

Whole-house standby generators

- Up to 20,000 watts
- Can cost \$7,000, plus installation
- Must be permanently installed by a professional electrician
- Turn on automatically during an outage
- Must be located outdoors
- Can power nearly all home appliances and electronics simultaneously

Portable generators

- Up to 7,500 watts
- Cost anywhere from \$400 to a few thousand dollars
- Will need to be manually started when power goes out
- If connected directly to your home's electrical panel, MUST include a transfer switch to break the circuit and prevent backfeed onto power lines
- Must be located outdoors
- Can power fridge, gas furnace, 10,000 BTU air conditioner, dishwasher, multiple lights, TV, laptop, and more

Inverter generators

- Sizes available from a few hundred watts up to 7,500 watts
- Costs similar to a portable generator
- Only produce the amount of power that is being used by your home, making them more fuel-efficient
- Must be located outdoors
- Electricity capabilities vary, depending upon wattage of the unit

Power stations

- Come in a wide range of sizes, but average-sized models range from a few hundred watts up to about 1,000 watts
- Anywhere from a few hundred to several thousand dollars
- Essentially an oversized battery that charges while plugged in to a 110-volt outlet and can be use as a power source later
- Can be operated indoors
- Many include both AC and DC outlets, or even USB charging ports
- Small units may only charge a phone or laptop, while the largest can power several major appliances

The proper selection, use, and maintenance of a generator can provide great convenience during a power outage. However, it's important to also remember that if they are used incorrectly, generators can be extremely hazardous. Always thoroughly read the owner's manual for important safety information before you operate a generator.

BOARD MEETING *highlights*

Firelands Electric Cooperative's Board of Trustees met July 25 and covered the following items:

- Board President Dan Schloemer reported that the cooperative received 30 membership applications for approval by the board.
