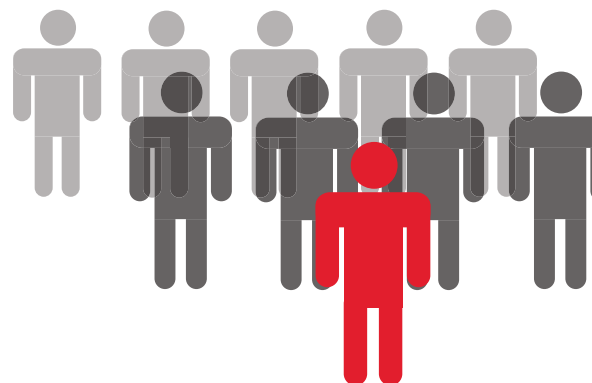

Cooperatives are not like other businesses — but operating differently actually benefits a co-op's members and the communities it serves. As we celebrate National Co-op Month, it's the perfect time to take a look at what makes cooperatives like Firelands Electric stand out.

We're in the people business

While most businesses offer a product or service in order to turn a profit, co-ops are in the “people business” — we exist for the sole purpose of serving you, our members, by providing safe, dependable electric power and first-rate customer service. This service still comes with a fee but, unlike other types of utilities, this charge is at cost. In other words, Firelands Electric Cooperative doesn't mark up the price of our services to make a profit.

Because the membership owns the cooperative, margins left over at the end of the fiscal year are allocated to members as capital credits, giving you a stake (or share) in the cooperative. When the co-op's finances are healthy enough, these credits are then retired and returned to the membership. While other companies pay margins to shareholders, Firelands pays them to the consumer.

Firelands Electric's service goes beyond just providing electricity and maintaining power lines. Cooperative employees teach electrical safety through demonstrations for first responders and youth programs. They help members locate potential sources of energy waste in their homes. They also provide information on options for assistance if a member struggles to pay their bill due to unforeseen circumstances. We power more than just homes and businesses — we also power people.

We help members save energy — and money

The cooperative prides itself on helping members use electricity wisely. Unlike other utility companies, Firelands doesn't focus purely on kilowatt-hour sales. Our rebate programs help members save energy and money by purchasing efficient appliances, electric water heaters, and HVAC equipment. Members can also take advantage of the cooperative's energy advisors to find

ways to reduce their electricity consumption. An in-home, energy consultation is even available for members at no cost.

Our knowledgeable employees are also here to answer any questions you may have regarding solar panels and other renewable energy sources, electric needs for new construction, and energy efficiency upgrades to existing homes and businesses. EMPLOYEE NEWS

COMMITTED TO THE GLOBAL COMMUNITY

In August, Firelands Electric's Rob Swiger was one of 16 linemen recognized at the Ohio's Electric Cooperatives Summer Conference for their participation in Project Ohio.

The presentation acknowledged the efforts of the group, which worked to bring electricity to the remote village of Tierra Blanca Sebol in northern Guatemala in March 2020. It was the first time this village of roughly 650 residents had electric power in their homes and school.

Taking part in the presentation was 6th U.S. Congressional District Representative Bill Johnson, who represents 18 counties along the east and southeast border of Ohio. Johnson, along with senators Rob Portman and Sherrod Brown and representatives Troy Balderson, Bob Gibbs, and Bob Latta, teamed up to get the linemen home to Ohio after Guatemala's borders closed due to COVID-19.

Just a few days into the group's project, cases of the virus started to pop up in Ohio. At first, there was not much cause for alarm. But within days, areas across North America were closing down, leaving the linemen with no means to get back to the United States. Representative Johnson and his fellow legislators worked to arrange a private flight to Miami, Florida, and get it cleared by both Guatemalan and U.S. officials. Once in the U.S., the group was finally able to take a flight home to Ohio.

Despite COVID cutting the project short, linemen were able to complete 98% of the work they set out to do. Local crews energized the village for the first time shortly after Ohio's group was forced to pull out.

Rob Swiger is Firelands' third lineman to take part in the Project Ohio initiative. Chris Rowland participated in 2018 and Rick Bowers in 2016. Reflecting on his experience, Swiger said, "I'll always be thankful for having had this opportunity. Participating in this project makes you even more grateful for what we have here at home."

ENERGY-WASTING HABITS

No one intentionally wastes energy, but it's really easy to do. If any of these common energy-wasting habits seem familiar, it's time to make some changes.

1. Forgetting to change your furnace filter

A dirty air filter forces your heating or cooling system to work harder to keep you comfortable. Change your furnace filter at least every three months and more frequently if you have pets. Wait until you have a full load before you press the start button. Your clothes or dishes will still be fully cleaned, and you'll save energy and water.

4. Browsing in front of an open refrigerator

The time you spend deciding between lunchmeat and leftover pizza can cost you money. According to the Alliance to Save Energy, the average person spends about

ten hours a year looking at an open refrigerator or freezer. That's a lot of time for cold air to escape. Decide what you want and close the door.

5. Heating or cooling an empty house

Adjusting the temperature of your home when you are away is a cost-effective way to save energy, but it's easy to forget. Programmable thermostats optimize savings by automatically adjusting temperatures based on your schedule. Today's smart models provide advanced features, such as remote control and self-programming.

6. Leaving the lights on in empty rooms

This is one of the most common energy-wasting habits and, luckily, easy to fix. By simply turning off lights when you leave a room, you'll save energy and help your bulbs last longer. To save even more, install energy-efficient LEDs. They use 75% less energy than incandescent bulbs and last up to 50 times longer.

7. Falling asleep watching TV

You're relaxing and watching your favorite show when, suddenly, it's 3 a.m. and you wake up to an infomercial. A regular late-night TV habit can result in up to \$55 a year in energy waste. Click the off button if you're feeling drowsy or set a sleep timer before you snuggle in. If your set is older, also consider upgrading to an ENERGY STAR TV, which uses an average of 25% less energy than standard sets.

With a little extra time and effort, you can save energy and money today and all year long by breaking a few of these bad efficiency habits.
