



SmartHub Usage Planning Tool Instructions

Members can create a “marker” that can help track usage based on a specific event. For example, you can add a notation to your SmartHub account to designate the specific day that an appliance was turned on or off, or the days you were on vacation.

This allows members to see if these events affect their electric usage.

Set up instructions

- In SmartHub, under the My Usage tab, select “Planning”
- Click on “Add New”
- Select the type of marker
 - Point in time marker – specific dates
 - Range marker – span of more than one day
- Choose the date(s)
- Name the marker
- Add description (optional)
- Click “Submit Marker” button
- “Marker” now shows up in the Usage Explorer Daily View (under “My Usage” tab)
 - You can now visually see if an event affect usage
- Examples of possible applications include:
 - Turned off pool pump
 - Turned on new dehumidifier
 - Installed new furnace
 - Out of town on vacation
 - Had out of town guests staying in the home
 - Turned on/off a space heater
