THE POWER OF A PENNY

Electricity has become such a fundamental part of our lives that it's easy to forget how often we actually use it. Think of the appliances in your kitchen, for example. Besides the standard refrigerator and stove, you may also have a single-serve coffee maker, food processor, air fryer, and several other small household gadgets. Add in televisions, computers, gaming consoles, smartphones, and entertainment systems, and the number of devices requiring electricity in your home increases significantly.

While all of these modern conveniences require electricity to operate, there is good news — electric power is still a bargain when compared to other items we buy on a regular basis.

Let's take a more in-depth look. Firelands Electric Cooperative's average residential cost for one kilowatt-hour (kWh) of electricity is 13.4 cents. Sixty minutes of using 1,000 watts of electricity costs a little over a dime, and the price of 80 watts of electricity equals just one penny. While 80 watts doesn't sound like much, it is enough to power a 9-watt LED lightbulb — the equivalent of a 60-watt incandescent bulb — for about 9 hours, all for just one penny.

The value of electricity is also evident when powering other things in your home. Take your smartphone, for instance. Using the same 13.4 cents per kWh price, you can fully charge an iPhone around 15 times for a penny. For less than a quarter, you can charge it once every day of the year!



Just a penny's worth of electricity gets Firelands Electric Cooperative members four and a half minutes of powering a 1,000-watt microwave on high; 20 minutes of running a 200-watt desktop computer; or 2 hours of watching your favorite shows on a 40-watt, 32-inch, LED television. The examples are endless.

Where else can you get that kind of value? For example, how much milk, bread, coffee, or gasoline will a penny buy? Not much in today's economy.

According to the U.S. Department of Labor's Consumer Price Index, the cost of electricity was 1.8 times higher in 2018 than it was in 1936. During this same eight-decade period, milk and bacon jumped 6.5 and 18.5 times, respectively. At around \$2.75 per gallon, today's gasoline costs roughly 9.5 times more than its price of 29 cents per gallon in 1955.

As consumers, we are fortunate that electricity is such an excellent value because we have such a large appetite for it. Electricity itself is not expensive. It's simply that we use it for so much more these days: lighting, heating, cooling, cooking, refrigeration, cleaning, washing, pumping, entertainment, communications, and even transportation. The average home now has ten Wi-Fi connected devices, and that amount continues to grow.

As the availability and use of electronic devices expands, Firelands Electric members will depend upon the cooperative for more than just power to keep the lights on. That's why your cooperative is always working to provide service that's reliable, affordable, and valuable to you, your family, and your neighbors.

POWER GENERATION

CREATING KILOWATTS

Firelands Electric Cooperative members visited their power plant on Oct. 3 to see how and where their electric power is generated.

Thirty-six cooperative members and guests, including ten New London Middle School students, traveled to the Cardinal Power Plant, located along the Ohio River in Brilliant, Ohio. Following an introductory presentation, attendees participated in an hour-long guided tour of the plant.

Highlights of the Cardinal tour included the state-of-the-art control room and electrostatic precipitators that remove 99% of all fly ash particles. Also of interest was the 423-foot-high closed-cycle cooling tower, which keeps evaporation loss below 1.8%. These two features are just a portion of the more than \$1.2 billion in environmental measures that make Cardinal one of the cleanest coal-fired power plants in the world.

Owned by Ohio's 24 distribution cooperatives, Buckeye Power's Cardinal Plant has the capacity to produce 1,800 megawatts of electricity — that's over 1.8 million kilowatts. The plant provides power to over 380,000 cooperative homes and businesses in 77 of the state's 88 counties.

To produce electricity, the plant's pulverizers grind coal into a fine, talcum-powder-like consistency. The powdered coal is then burned at high temperatures, turning water into steam. This steam is directed into

turbines, which drive the generator that produces electricity.

Cardinal generates electricity the instant a co-op member needs it. Electricity is produced at 23,000 to 25,000 volts. Transformers outside the plant then step up the voltage to 138,000 and 345,000 volts, so that it can be transmitted efficiently to cooperative members' homes and businesses throughout Ohio.

Whether replacing an inefficient heat pump, adding attic insulation, or sealing up that leaky rim joist, fall is the perfect time to make upgrades to your home. Completing these types of energy efficient improvement projects before cold winter weather sets in will make your home more comfortable — and save money on your electric bills.

To help stretch those savings even further, Firelands Electric Cooperative offers members a variety of rebates for investing in energy-efficient updates:

- **New or replacement heat pump or geothermal system:** \$200–\$800
- **Insulation upgrades:** up to \$800
- **Air-sealing improvements:** up to \$400
- **New or replacement water heater:** \$150–\$300
- **Replace appliances with ENERGY STAR-certified models:** \$25–\$100

In order to qualify for rebates, all home improvement projects must meet energy efficiency and other program requirements as outlined in Firelands Electric Cooperative's guidelines, which are available at www.firelandsec.com/content/member-programs.
