## MOVE OVER . . . THERE'S A BETTER BURGER IN TOWN

Visit one of the numerous annual festivals in Huron or Ashland counties and you'll find some of our favorite foods, such as fries, corn dogs, funnel cakes, and caramel apples. However, if you're looking for a tasty change of pace among this typical fare, be sure to check out Great Plains Bison Burgers.

When Brenda Wilson, Great Plains' owner and operator, was first looking to start her concession business, she did a great deal of research. "I wanted to offer something totally different — and a healthier option — than your standard fair food," Brenda says.

In 2004, Brenda went into the business of bison burgers. She purchased a used concession trailer and spent over six months remodeling it to fit her needs. The biggest challenge, though, was finding a reliable bison supplier. After investigating more than a dozen companies, Brenda found the perfect match in North Dakota. "I wanted 100 percent bison," Brenda says, "and this company has been able to deliver." In fact, in most cases, she has her order the very next day.

While bison meat is often mixed with pork, Brenda insists on pure bison for its health benefits. According to the National Bison Association, bison meat has

26 percent more iron and 87 percent less fat than beef. It's higher in iron and vitamin B-12, as well. "Bison also has a slightly sweeter and richer flavor than grain-fed beef," Brenda points out.

In addition to burgers, Great Plains has several other all-bison options available. Hot dogs, sloppy joes, and even fried bologna are on the menu. The burgers remain the most popular, however. "On several occasions, we've sold nearly 300 burgers in a single day," Brenda says.

For those who are a bit skeptical about trying something out of their comfort zone, Brenda's always happy to share samples of her bison hot dogs — and the majority come back for more.

Brenda and her daughter, Amanda Kidd, set the Great Plains trailer up at eight to ten events each year, mainly between May and mid-October. Brenda regularly attends New London's Firelands Festival and F.A.R.M. Show, the Norwalk Jaycees Strawberry Festival, events at the Grist Mill in Loudonville, and the biannual Great Mohican Pow Wows. "I'm always looking for additional opportunities, though," she says.

### Generator safety made simple

Portable generators allow homeowners to power critical appliances such as furnaces, pumps, refrigerators, and freezers during a power outage. If you have a standby generator for emergencies, it is a National Electrical Code requirement to have a double throw transfer

switch installed. This is to protect you, your family, your home, and the cooperative's linemen.

Firelands Electric Cooperative offers a simple and reasonably priced option to safely connect a generator to your home's electrical

system. The GenerLink™ makes it easy to connect your portable generator and supply standby power to any circuit in your home. Once a Firelands Electric technician installs a Generlink behind your electric meter, simply plug one end of the power cable into the device and the other end into your generator — and you are all set!

GenerLink devices may only be purchased from Firelands Electric by co-op members. A 12-month, interest-free payment plan is available and installation is FREE. Devices are available in several sizes and cord lengths.

## Members visit their power plant

Earlier this fall, Firelands Electric Co-op members had the opportunity to see how and where their electric power is generated.

On Sept. 12, thirty-six cooperative members and guests, including 10 South Central Middle School students, traveled to the Cardinal Power Plant, located along the Ohio River in Brilliant, Ohio. Attendees participated in an informative presentation and hour-long guided tour of the plant.

Owned by Ohio's 24 distribution cooperatives, Buckeye Power's Cardinal Plant provides power to nearly 400,000 electric co-op members across the state.

Highlights of the tour included the state-of-the-art control room and electrostatic precipitators that remove 99 percent of all fly ash particles. Also of interest was the 423-foot-high closed-cycle cooling tower, which keeps evaporation loss below 1.8 percent. These features, in



addition to more than \$1 billion in other environmental upgrades, make Cardinal one of the cleanest coal-fired power plants in the world.

# BOARD MEETING *highlights*

*Firelands Electric Cooperative's board of trustees met Aug. 28 and covered the following items:*

- Board President Dan Schloemer reported the cooperative received 49 membership applications for approval by the board.
- Director of Finance and Accounting Tabi Shepherd reviewed the July financials and reported on recent accounting and billing department activities.
- The board reviewed the report for a safety and training meeting held Aug. 9.
- General Manager Dan McNaull reviewed information regarding commercial appraisals of the co-op's existing buildings. The manager was authorized by the board to proceed with the appraisal.
- Dan McNaull asked the board to revisit the co-op's OurSolar (OS) rate schedule. The manager advised that bills will reflect the solar energy charge, with a credit for the power plant energy charge. Following review, the board revised and approved the cooperative's OS rate.
- Management updated the board on the status of constructing the cooperative's new facility and advised that the building was on schedule.

- The board was advised that management had renewed the cooperative's builders risk insurance, and McNaull reviewed charges with the board.
- McNaull advised that Firelands Electric received payment for pole contacts from the companies attaching to the cooperative's poles.
- Director of Member Services and Communications Andrea Gravenhorst reviewed the 2018 Member Attitude Survey with the board. The cooperative's American Customer Satisfaction Index score of 86 was the same that Firelands Electric received last year.
- Director of Electric Operations Don Englet reported on recent projects and crew activities in the operations department.
- Andrea Gravenhorst updated the board on recent projects and activities involving the member services department.
